You will not hold Newville Parade Committee, Newville Historical Society, or Newville Borough, its officers, and members, liable for any damages or liability incurred for any reason.

- 1. **Safety First:** All parade participants must follow the directives from all volunteers and borough officials to ensure the safety of everyone involved in the parade.
- 2. **Candy Distribution:** To prioritize safety, participants will not to throw candy into the street. This can prevent children from running into the streets, where they could be injured. Instead, we encourage you to distribute candy directly to the children or along the side of the street where they are standing or sitting.
- 3. **No Harmful Objects:** Parade participants are not allowed to distribute or use any harmful objects, such as sharp items or anything that may cause injury to spectators or fellow participants.
- 4. **Respect for Property:** Participants should respect public and private property along the parade route. Do not damage or deface any property during the parade.
- 5. **Costume Appropriateness:** All costumes worn during the parade should be appropriate for a family-friendly event. Avoid any offensive or inappropriate costumes.
